END OF THE PACIFIC WHITING PRIMARY SEASON
FOR THE SHORE-BASED SECTOR SOUTH OF 42° N. LAT

This notice announces achievement of the shore-based sector allocation specified at 50 CFR 660.323(a) for the fishery south of 42° N. lat. The best available information on May 14, 2010 indicates that 1,289 metric tons (mt) of whiting had been taken through May 12, 2010 and that the 2,961 mt shore-based allocation for the early season fishery south of 42° N. lat will be reached by 8 pm (local time) May 16, 2010. Therefore, the following action is taken in accordance with the regulations at 50 CFR 660.323(b)(4):

Effective 8 pm (local time) May 16, 2010 until 0001 hours June 15, 2010, the shore-based Pacific whiting fishery south of 42° N. lat is closed. "Per trip" limits for whiting will be reinstated until 0001 hours June 15, 2010, at which time the primary season for the shore based sector will be open coastwide. Offloading must begin before the time the fishery closes.
